CAMPER/PARENT CONTRACT: 2012 SEASON

In order to clarify the camp's "Standards of Behavior" and camp's "Disciplinary Code" for participation, it might be helpful to review the following issues that occasionally arise.

**Camper may be sent home for the following reasons:**

- Striking with malice, biting, kicking, attacking, jumping on or provoking of fights with any camp member, staff or parent.
- Throwing of sand, rocks or any other items that are not meant to be thrown including shoes, chairs, sticks, etc.
- Running away from the camper's group. Coaches will be trained to encourage participation, however, campers must understand that they are not permitted to run away from the coaches or the camp area at any time.
- Roughhousing, horseplay and violent games will not be part of the camp.
- Distasteful, derogatory or spiteful jokes, comments and stories are not acceptable in any area of the camp program.
- Continual failure to follow the rules and directions of the staff.
