Lighting:

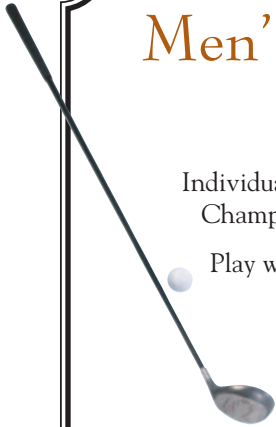
